At approximately 1 05 pm on Thursday 8th of May 1997 I was at Portadown College when I was approached by another student namely Linda Boyle. She was alone when she approached me and she appeared visibly upset. I knew Linda Boyle was the girlfriend of Dean Forbes. She asked me if she could have a word with me and I said yes. Both of us moved away to the side of the corridor and she said, "Dean is in a lot of trouble with this thing that has happened." She then said, "Did you see him that night because he seen you." I then said, "Where." She said, "Apparently up the town." I replied, "No I didn't see him." She then said, "Do you know what he was wearing," and before I could answer her, she went on to say that he was wearing a cream Ralph Lauren shirt with black jeans. I said to her, "No I didn't see him," and that was the end of the conversation.
