Further to my statement dated 7 December 2000 I have been asked to clarify the following points. I first informed H of my knowledge of Timothy Jameson when we met on 29 November 2000. When we went to Portadown Station me and Davy McCaw would have been in the Detective Inspectors office for about 5-10 minutes. I cannot recall verbatim what Davy McCaw told the Detective Inspector but I am almost 100% sure that Timothy Jameson's comments about putting the boot in would have been relayed. The Detective Inspector brought us to the Detective Superintendent's office. The meeting would have lasted no more than 15-20 minutes and the Detective Inspector would have been present throughout. Davy McCaw would have told the Detective Superintendent exactly what he would have told the Detective Inspector. I cannot recall if either the Detective Inspector or the Detective Superintendent gave me or McCaw any instructions about the information they had been given by Davy McCaw. I cannot understand why neither me or Davy McCaw made notebook entries concerning what Timothy Jameson had told us. I am not sure whether the Detective Superintendent told us not to make entries. I had no further dealings with the Detective Inspector or the Detective Superintendent following
