I live at an address known to police. My husband is [REDACTED] who is the uncle of Tracey Clarke. I remember hearing about Robert Hamill being assaulted in Portadown. I heard about this the Sunday morning after the incident. Sometime between the following Monday and the next weekend I was speaking to my husband's sister [REDACTED] and her husband Jim Murray. One of them said that Tracey, [REDACTED] daughter had to go to the police station and she was taken by Andrea McKee to make a statement about what happened the night Robert Hamill was assaulted. I'm not sure whether Alistair Harvey was going with Tracey at this time. I didn't know whether it was on or off at this time. I mean Tracey and Alistair's relationship. At some stage Jim or [REDACTED] told myself and [REDACTED] that Robbie Atkinson had told Alistair Harvey to burn his clothes. I don't know exactly how they knew this, whether it was Tracey or Alistair who had told them. At some stage during this I'm not sure when, [REDACTED] or Jim told us that Tracey was going to make a statement. Tracey was worried about threats that were being made against her and the fact she was afraid of her home being
