

I refer to previous correspondence. I would be obliged if you can have the following matters attended to:-

1. The maps referred to during and after caution interviews with your witnesses Reserve Constable Atkinson and Constable Neill should be made available together with any such maps from witnesses you are not calling, e.g. Reserve Constable Cornett and Reserve Constable <sup>P40</sup> [redacted]
2. Baton report forms concerning Neill and Atkinson are both available and have yet to be disclosed. I would be obliged for same by return.
3. I would be obliged for confirmation of the decision of the Department of the Director of Public Prosecutions concerning whether or not any Police Officer involved in this case and in particular Neill, Atkinson, <sup>P40</sup> [redacted] and Cornett are to be prosecuted for any offence. As they have been interviewed under caution in September 1997 for offences including criminal neglect on duty, assisting offenders and withholding information about an arrestable offence, it is clear that any such DPP decision should long since have been made. I should be obliged for confirmation of same. Such information is obviously crucial and has a bearing on the Trial of my Client Hobson.
