within a matter of hours so I mean I can't". There is reference to the Ombudsman saying he does not want to go into the issue about Constable Atkinson. There is an obvious suggestion that he therefore may go into this issue at a later time in the interview. If that is the case those are certainly matters which should be disclosed. On the same page there is a question if he met Andrea McKee on the 8th or 9th and then just 8th. Presumably there is a further question about meeting her on the 9th or other questions. I simply don't know.

3. It is clear from what has been supplied concerning D I Irwin that I have some thirty pages out of forty five. With regard to Mr McBurney I have approximately eight pages out of fifty.

4. It is also apparent that these interviews were after some sort of caution but the exact nature of that caution is not disclosed. Surely I am entitled to have at least that.

5. Dealing specifically with how D I Irwin took a statement from Andrea McKee in the Solicitor's Office, there is a huge amount of material edited going on the various page numbers. It is hard to imagine that the interviewing persons were skipping around topic to topic. It seems inescapable that the matters that have been edited are relevant to this area.

6. D I Irwin has particularly been put forward as a witness of truth and credibility and presume will be a witness who was diligent in how he prepared the statements, notebook entries and other matters. Considering the very limited amount of evidence against Kenneth Hanvey and the significance of Detective Inspector Irwin concerning it, I feel that I am entitled to the entirety of his interview. Again I do not know what he was being interviewed about and the nature of the caution. Significantly there are some questions posed at the bottom of what is called page 92 of his interview and one other question on the next page which does not have a number. This matter then does not come back at all in the portion that has been disclosed to me. Surely it must do? It is inescapable that if it does re-appear, I should be entitled to this.

7. There are other portions dealing with how he dealt with Andrea McKee on other occasions which have limited disclosure. Again it seems unlikely that these just came out of the blue as the entirety of these have been disclosed. I respectfully suggest that the entire interview should be disclosed without any further delay. I will of course reserve the right to have this
