RESULT OF A150 INTERVIEW OF N29 MILLIGAN

KENNETH MILLIGAN has been interviewed by myself at his home address [REDACTED] in the presence of his mother.

He relates that he went to Lee Stockdale's home at [REDACTED] Portadown at about 7 pm on Saturday 26 April 1997. Also there were Lee Stockdale and Mark Brown. They drank and listened to music until about 12 midnight when the three of them left the house and walked to Connaught Pk and onto the Armagh Road. A policewoman spoke to them on Armagh Rd and told them not to be making noise as there was elderly residents in that area. They then continued to Cecil St to Milligan's home.

On leaving there they walked along Armagh Rd to the Esso Garage and then to Jervis St. They remained in the Jervis St, Craigavon Avenue all night until after dawn talking. Also in their company during the evening were Lisa Hobson [REDACTED] full name not know, [REDACTED] and his girlfriend, and Noelle Moore. A police patrol stopped with them after dawn and enquired who they were and what they were doing and if they had been down the town earlier.

Milligan can't remember when he heard about the Hamill incident, or from whom. He can add nothing of an evidential nature.

He declined to make a written witness statement.
