

CONCLUSIONS

Please see "CONCLUSIONS" at Part I, Pages 43-49 and 54 in particular Paragraph 123 and penultimate paragraph of page 54.

The claims by Colin Hull and Vincent McNeice that police ignored a plea for help and remained in the landrover until arrival of the ambulance are simply not true on the weight of the overall evidence.

The Director of Public Prosecutions has decided that there is no reasonable prospect of convicting any Police Officer on the evidence and it is considered that the same criteria applies to Discipline. The evidence is equally not sufficient to warrant disciplinary proceedings.

R/Constable is no longer a member of the RUC Reserve since 27 January 2000 due to non renewal of contract.

R/Constable is presently in line for a medical discharge.
