STATEMENT OF LISA MARIE HOBSON

I, LISA MARIE HOBSON, declare that this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that if it is tendered in evidence at the Inquiry, I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

1. The Inquiry has disclosed a number of documents to me. Where I make specific reference to a document in my statement I have given the number of the relevant page.
2. I have lived in Portadown all my life. In April 1997 I was 16 years old and I attended school. My parents had separated and I was moving around to live with different friends at that time. Tracey McAlpine and Pauline Newell are my step-sisters.
3. I remember completing a police questionnaire on 29 April 1997 about my movements on the night of 26 – 27 April 1997. The questionnaire is contained at pages **08107** to **08108**.
4. I am told that the police asked me to complete second questionnaire but I refused to answer any of the questions. This questionnaire is contained at pages **70973** to **70975**. I do not recall being seen by police and refusing to answers their questions.
5. I recall that DC **P6** coming to see me at my mother's house on 12 May 1997 to ask me questions. My mother is [REDACTED] DC **P6**'s notes of that interview are
