STATEMENT OF LYNN KAREN KENNEDY

DATED THIS 15TH **DAY OF** April **2008**

I, LYNN KAREN KENNEDY, declare that this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that if it is tendered in evidence at the Inquiry I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

1. The Inquiry has disclosed a number of documents to me. Where I make specific reference to a document in my statement I have given the number of the relevant page.
2. I joined the Royal Ulster Constabulary in 1978 and retired from the PSNI in 2007 as a Chief Superintendent.
3. On 12 April 2001, I was appointed to investigate possible breaches of discipline by officers present at the disturbance in Portadown town centre involving Robert Hamill on 27 April 1997.
4. At that time I had recently been posted as a Superintendent to the Complaints and Discipline Department (C & D). I was appointed to investigate concerns which had been raised by Detective Chief Superintendent Colville Stewart when he was SIO on the Robert Hamill murder investigation. In January 2001, Mr Stewart had reported to the Chief Constable those concerns which centred on scene management, a lack of debriefing and an arrest strategy.
