

were standing outside the Church. It was parked somewhere on the High Street. I believe that it was parked on the side of the Halifax bank, but I cannot be sure. I do not remember seeing any police officers outside or around the Land Rover when the fight first kicked off. The police did not intervene right away. I cannot remember at exactly what point I saw police officers and when they intervened, but they were there at the end. It seemed longer than five minutes but it would not have been as long as half an hour. I know that in my statement I also mentioned seeing a police car outside Wellworths, on the Thomas Street side of the High Street, but I cannot remember the police car now at all. I do remember a police car with two tone horns. I cannot remember exactly how they did it, but the police ushered everyone up through the town, past the Church and away from the centre of town.

15. I think that Victoria and I would have stood at the Church for a few minutes, maybe five minutes in total. Our reaction was that we wanted to leave. When we saw the police ushering the crowd, we just turned and walked away. We then walked to Victoria's house. I know in my statement I said that Kyle walked with us up to the bridge on the Armagh Road. However, I do not remember this now. As I said, I do not remember Kyle being with us that evening at all but I accept that I have mentioned being with him in my 1997 statement. I have been told that Kyle said that he walked towards the fight with me and Victoria and that he got close to the fight. That is not correct: I definitely did not walk towards the fight, and I certainly did not get closer to it.
16. I am told that Victoria said that she wiped blood from a man's face or handed him a handkerchief, and that someone else observed that this man was Stacey Bridgett. I do not remember seeing this and I was with Victoria the entire time that night. Nor can I remember talking with Victoria about this at any stage. I do remember seeing Stacey Bridgett and Dean Forbes in the town centre that night but do not know now if they were also on the Coach Inn bus.
