STATEMENT OF MONICA O'REILLY

I, MONICA O'REILLY, declare that this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that if it is tendered in evidence at the Inquiry I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

1. The Inquiry has disclosed a number of documents to me. Where I make specific reference to a document in my statement I have given the number of the relevant page.
2. This is the first witness statement that I have made in connection with the Robert Hamill incident.
3. I can confirm that I have never lived in Portadown. But in April 1997, I worked at the Alliance & Leicester Building Society on High Street, Portadown. I had been an employee for 18 years, but had only worked at the Portadown branch for about 2 years. I was a Mortgage Advisor and Temporary Manager at that time, but had nothing to do with CCTV or security.
4. The branch was fitted with a number of security cameras, but there was only one recorder. I have been shown a photograph of the outside of the branch which contains page number 222, and there are 4 external cameras visible. I would imagine that 1 camera recorded the ATM, which was further from the door on the High Street; another camera faced down Woodhouse Street, on a corner site; and 2 others faced onto Portadown Street, capturing the front door of the branch. I do not
