

8. I am now informed that when the police viewed the tapes, they did not show any night scenes. I am surprised to hear this because night recordings were precisely the purpose of the tapes, and the reason why we carried out the task of changing tapes at the weekend.

9. I am also asked whether, if people were standing on the corner of Woodhouse Street and along High Street on the night in question, I would have expected some of it to have been recorded. I suppose it depends exactly where the cameras were pointing and where the incident happened. It may have been that there was no camera pointing over in the exact direction, so perhaps the cameras did not pick up anything.

10. To my knowledge, no other police officers or investigators came to me, or to anyone else at the branch, to enquire about those tapes subsequently. I stopped working for the Alliance and Leicester in July 1997, so I had no further involvement in the investigation. It is possible that other members of staff were involved with the police about the tapes after I had left.
