I, P133, declare that this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that if it is tendered in evidence at the Inquiry I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

1. The Inquiry has disclosed a number of documents to me. Where I make specific reference to a document in my statement I have given the number of the relevant page.
2. In 1997 I was 32. I lived in an area called 'The Beeches' with my husband P132. He used to work part-time for A-2-B Taxis. I knew that Robert Hamill was P132's cousin but I did not know him personally.
3. On the night of 26th / 27th April 1997 I went with my husband P132 to St. Patrick's Hall. We would not have walked there so we probably got a taxi. We used to go there regularly, not every Saturday night but we felt happy to go there. It was probably just the two of us and I do not recall if we went anywhere else first. I do not remember seeing P132's sisters E, F or [REDACTED] there that evening. They could have been there but we did not sit with them. I know Maureen McCoy and Colin Prunty from the area we live in but I do not know if they were at St. Patrick's that night. I know Dermot McNeice and Thomas Mallon, but I do not know Colin Hull.
4. At the end of the night we could not get a taxi and I remember that I was really afraid of walking down the town because of the trouble there. We would avoid walking home if at all possible. At that time a Catholic could not walk down through the town. But there were no taxis and so we had no choice but to walk home. I remember my husband saying "You'll be all right. Just run for it."
